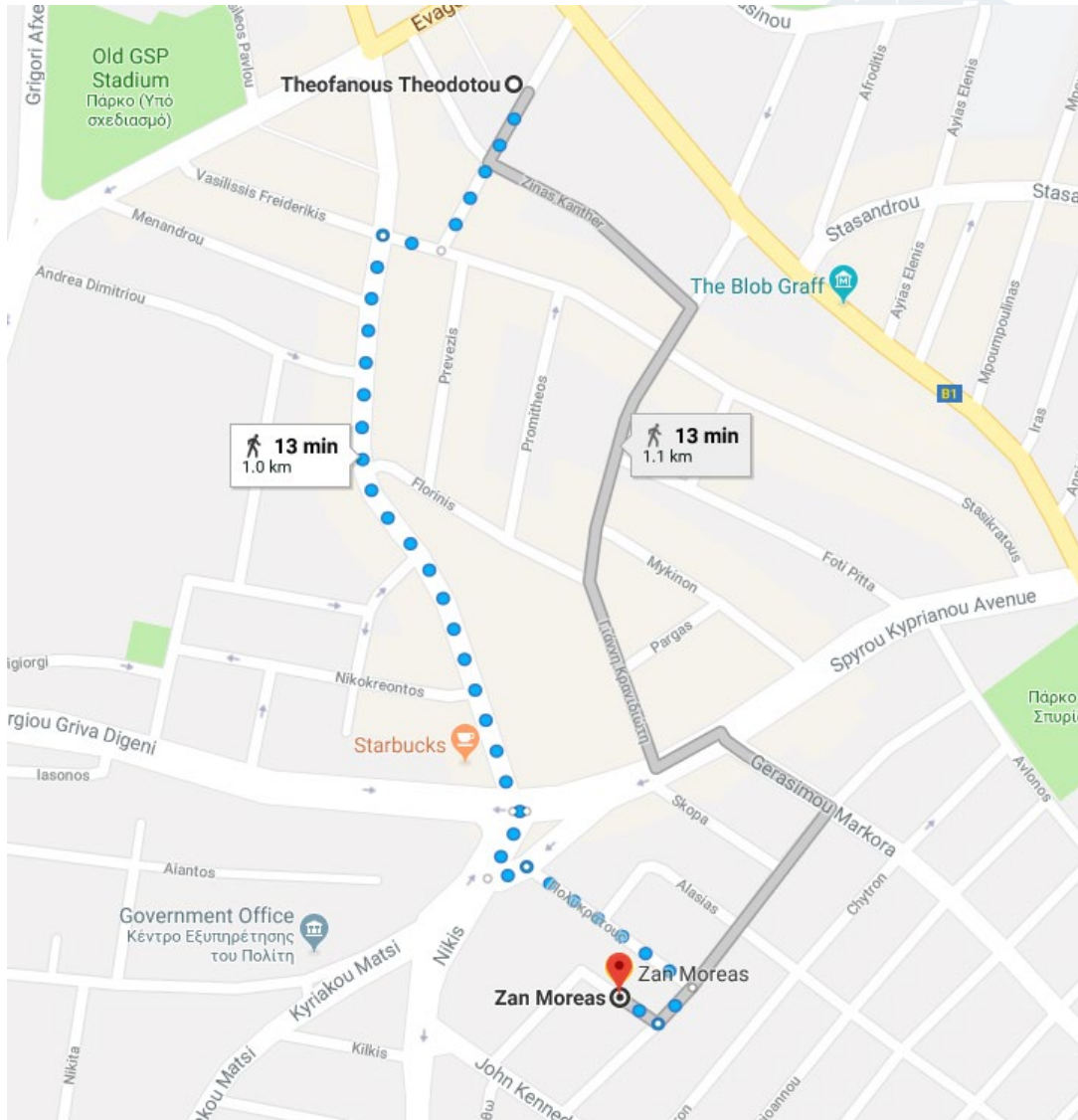

# Important Policies

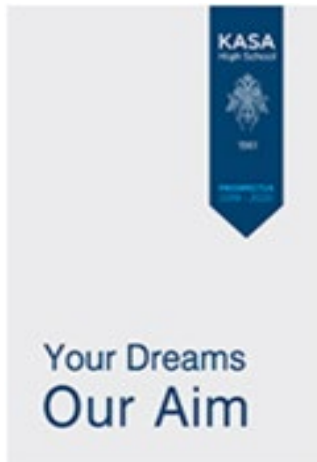

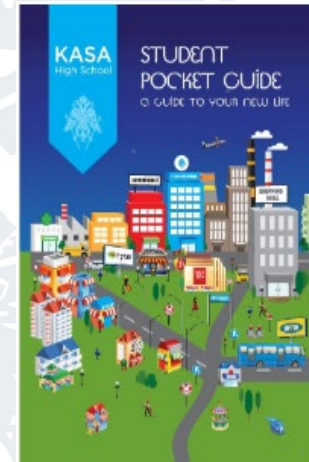

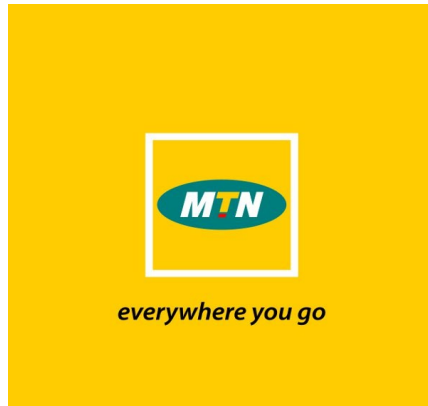
